

## EVERY SCHOOL DAY COUNTS

## Every single day a child is absent from school equates to a day of lost learning.

Attendance percentages can be misleading. For some parents/carers, 90% may seem like an acceptable level of attendance, but the reality is that <u>90% attendance means that your child</u> <u>will miss half a school day each week</u> or 19 days of school during the school year – that's nearly 4 school weeks.

95% Attendance	9 days of absence  1 Week and 4 Days  of Learning Missed	Satisfactory
90% Attendance	20 days of absence 4 Weeks and 0 Days of Learning Missed	Poor
85% Attendance	30 Days of Absence 6 Weeks and 0 Days of Learning Missed	Very Poor
80% Attendance	38 Days of Absence 7 Weeks and 3 Days of Learning Missed	Unacceptable
75% Attendance	46 Days of Absence 9 Weeks and 1 Day of Learning Missed	Unacceptable
