



EVERY SCHOOL DAY COUNTS

Every single day a child is absent from school equates to a day of lost learning.

Attendance percentages can be misleading. For some parents/carers, 90% may seem like an acceptable level of attendance, but the reality is that **90% attendance means that your child will miss half a school day each week** or 19 days of school during the school year – that's nearly 4 school weeks.

95% Attendance	9 days of absence <u>1 Week and 4 Days of Learning Missed</u>	Satisfactory
90% Attendance	20 days of absence <u>4 Weeks and 0 Days of Learning Missed</u>	Poor
85% Attendance	30 Days of Absence <u>6 Weeks and 0 Days of Learning Missed</u>	Very Poor
80% Attendance	38 Days of Absence <u>7 Weeks and 3 Days of Learning Missed</u>	Unacceptable
75% Attendance	46 Days of Absence <u>9 Weeks and 1 Day of Learning Missed</u>	Unacceptable
